

Export Licence Statistics

On 21st September, 2011 the Minister for Jobs, Enterprise and Innovation, Richard Bruton TD published the First Report under the Control of Exports Act 2008. That report covered the period 2008-2010. The 2008 Act provides the legal basis for export controls, the licensing regime and the overall regulatory environment relating to the export of dual use and military goods. In addition, a number of directly effective EU Regulations regulate the export of these goods from the EU.

The objective of providing an annual report under the Act is to provide the public with a much greater level of transparency about exports of controlled goods and services, and an understanding of how export control operates.

To provide more regular information, the Minister also decided to publish summary data on the export of controlled products on the Department's website.

The summary data Table below for 2011 is preliminary and subject to verification and change.
